In addition to ACCA update on strategic activities, we are pleased to have Dr. Carole Estabrooks joining us. Dr. Estabrooks is Professor, Faculty of Nursing at the University of Alberta, Principal Investigator of Translating Research in Elder Care (TREC).

Dr. Estabrooks supervises undergraduate and graduate students and postdoctoral fellows and teaches in the areas of knowledge translation and research design. Her research focuses on knowledge translation interventions, the role of organizational context in facilitating knowledge translation, the effect of knowledge translation on resident/patient and provider outcomes. She has developed the Alberta Context Tool, currently being used in eight countries and six languages with active translation projects ongoing.

Dr. Estabrooks will join us in talking about how both the long term care (LTC) work environment and LTC workforce shape the experience of frail and highly vulnerable older residents living with dementia in LTC. She will also draw some inferences with respect to how Home Care may affect LTC.
