

Register Now: Sparking Change in AUA Awards Program

You are invited to join the <u>Sparking Change in the Appropriate Use of Antipsychotics (AUA)</u> program offered by Healthcare Excellence Canada. This awards-based quality improvement program supports the appropriate use of antipsychotics through person-centred care and is open to long-term care (LTC) homes across the country.

Why join this program?

Across Canada, approximately 1 in 4 residents in LTC are taking potentially inappropriate antipsychotics without a diagnosis of psychosis. Rates were declining prior to 2020, but the COVID-19 pandemic reversed that trend (CIHI, 2022). Deprescribing these medications when they no longer benefit or cause harm can improve safety and quality of life, especially with supportive care strategies. Person-centred care is a proven and safer alternative that benefits residents, care partners and care providers.
